Our teacher features are easy to use and they give teachers access to our reports and class controls and settings.

This year we will do a better job of explaining those controls and features. Most of this information is available on our web site, but our Teacher Resources course puts all of those resources together in one easy to find and use system.

We also want to do a better job of signing teachers up for our monthly newsletter. If you are a current subscriber to Super Star Online for school, I would appreciate it if you would send me a list of your teachers and their emails (with their permission), so I can add them to our monthly newsletter. I feel that our monthly newsletter will help them understand more about Super Star Online and the changes that we make.
